JOB DESCRIPTION

Job Title: Youth Support Worker

Reporting to: Lead Youth Worker

Delivered in partnership with children and young people, the project is all about co-production, supporting young people to reach their goals as defined by them and lead the direction of the project based on their articulation of what they need or would like to “have a go at”.

Our priorities for the project are around early intervention, improving spaces and places that matter to communities, bringing people together and building strong relationships in and across communities. We want to provide young people with the **right activities and support, in the right place, at the right time.**

Main Duties:

1. To support the delivery of CLP universal access youth offer.
2. To work with young people to design, develop, deliver and evaluate the work offer supporting the personal development of young people and enabling them to develop emotional resilience, increase aspirations and become future leaders in their communities
3. To support the Lead Youth Worker in ensuring that outputs and outcomes are met.
4. To attend staff meetings, review meetings, supervision and training sessions as requested.
5. To have an understanding of child protection and safeguarding issues and act appropriately should issues of concern arise, including reporting to the session leader or Designated Safeguarding Lead and appropriate agencies.
6. To comply with CLP Health and Safety policy, data protection policy and to protect your own and other's health, safety and welfare.
7. To comply with CLP Diversity & Equality Policy in every aspect of your work and positively promote the principles of these policies amongst colleagues, service users and other members of the community.
